We do not have a photograph of this young man and only a short report from the Register of 4 November 1944:

Killed In Action

Lt. Reginald Longueville of the Coldstream Guards: killed in Holland. eldest son of Col. Longueville of Southfields, Forthampton; aged 21 he had served in the Home Guard.

His parents were Lt-Col. Francis Longueville, D S O, M. C. and Gertrude Beatrice Longueville. He was killed in the Netherlands, just before the invasion of Germany when the unit was clearing out, in severe fighting in October and November, the Nazi troops from the Maas region. We do not know if he was personally involved, but the *Coldstream Guards* had taken part in the failed *Arnhem* campaign. If so, he had survived to play his part in the Liberation of the Netherlands.
