**Visit to the University of Gloucestershire's Special Collections Library
at the Hardwick Campus, St Paul's Road, Cheltenham GL50 4BS**

with Special Collections and University Archivist Louise Hughes

Monday 17 April 2023

Two visit times - 11am and 2pm.

There will be 10 spaces available for each visit. There is no charge.

Each visit will be led by Louise Hughes, the University's Special Collections Archivist, and will comprise an introductory talk, a tour of the Library and a chance to see a selection of items from the Special Collections. There will also be time to browse the Bristol & Gloucestershire Archaeological Society's extensive Library, which may be used (by appointment) by members of local history groups and the general public.

The formal part of the visit will last for around 40 minutes, but those attending are welcome to stay to browse the BGAS Library until either 1pm or 4pm.

We will meet outside the Campus Administration Centre, which is on the left immediately after entering the Campus from St Paul's Road. Please arrive 10 minutes before the visit time to enable us to make a prompt start.

There is ample Pay and Display parking at the Campus - £1.60 for 3 hours (cash and cards). There is a ticket machine outside the Administration Centre.
