The blue Rover at The Holy Innocents Church in Highnam, a Grade I listed Gothic Revival building, commissioned by Thomas Gambier Parry, the owner of nearby Highnam Court. His son, Sir Charles Hubert Hastings Parry (1848 - 1918), composed the tune to William Blake's Jerusalem. He was the organist at Highnam and tutored the great English Composer, Sir Edward William Elgar.

The white Rover at Cotswold Airport, formerly known as the RAF Kemble Britannia Airfield. Commissioned in 1938 as a RAF training school and from 1966 to 1983, the home of the Red Arrows aerobatic display team and their Follant Gnats and BAE Hawk jets. The airfield was later used by the US Airforce during the Cold War.
